3. The Bayosphere staff practices blind judging procedures. The names of all participants are logged into a journal and each piece of work submitted is assigned a corresponding entry number. Please do not include your name on your entries. Please remember that taking another writer's or artist's work and putting your name on it is plagiarism, a serious offense when publication is involved.
4. Have any of these works been previously published? _____ If so, do you still retain the copyrights? _____

Please note that per copyright law, all photographs/artwork depicting another artist's work (i.e. statue, architecture, sculpture, etc.) must include the original artist's permission to be considered for publication, unless the 70 years past the artist's lifespan has expired.

How to submit work or direct inquiries: A completed entry form must accompany submitted work. Submissions may be mailed to: Bayosphere, University of Houston-Clear Lake, 2700 Bay Area Blvd., Box 456, Houston, TX 77058, or delivered to the Student Publications Office, room 1239 in the Bayou Building. The Student Publications Office is officially closed in June and July; however, entries may still be mailed during that period. Submissions to Bayosphere are accepted throughout the year. Entries must be received no later than **Sept. 15, 2008** to be considered for publication in the spring issue. All submissions not chosen for the spring issue of Bayosphere 2008 will be resubmitted automatically for the fall issue. The deadline for the fall issue is **Feb. 15, 2008**.
